
# General Government Budget

- **Legislative Auditor General**
- **State**
- **Technology, Management, and Budget (includes Civil Service Commission and Information Technology)**
- **Treasury (includes Bureau of State Lottery, Michigan Gaming Control Board, Michigan Strategic Fund, and Michigan State Housing Development Authority)**

# General Government: Gross Appropriations



General Government makes up 7.1% of the total state GF/GP budget


FY 2010-11 GF/GP Total = \$8,301,784,800

# General Government Funding Sources


FY 2010-11 General Government Budget = \$3,321,660,100


# General Government Gross by Department
